The purpose of the North Arkansas Naz Kidz camp is to give your child the greatest gift of all – a relationship with Jesus Christ along with tools to help him or her to grow in faith. The Camp Staff want only the best for our children; therefore, that is what we give to them – our absolute best. We are here to model Jesus for each and every camper and use creative means to share His love with every child.

We encourage you to write your child. All campers love receiving mail. When writing to your camper, please do so as early as possible so they will receive it while at camp. If you wish to have your camper send you a letter or postcard, you will need to supply the material and stamp.

What Should I Bring to Camp?

- Bible
- Sleeping Bag or bedding
- Pillow
- Toothpaste, toothbrush
- Tennis Shoes and shower shoes
- Casual clothes
- Swimsuit (please keep modesty in mind)
- Towels, washcloths, shampoo and soap
- Plastic bags for dirty and wet clothes
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen and Insect repellent
- Prescription medication in original package with a signed note to be given to nurse at registration
- Parents, please mark ALL items brought with child's name using a permanent marker.

What Shouldn't I Bring?

- Fireworks
- Ipods/mp3/cd players
- Videos
- Electronic Games
- Cellular phones
- Knives, guns, or weapons
- Water guns
- Shaving cream
- Expensive clothes or shoes

Camp Guidelines:

1. Proper respect of the camp rules, other campers and staff will be expected of all campers. This includes proper respect and use of camp facilities.
2. Appropriate attire that emphasizes modesty will be worn at all times.
3. Possession of illegal drugs, firearms, or tobacco will result in immediate suspension from camp.
4. Campers are not permitted to have cell phones, electronics, or water guns on the campgrounds. If they are brought to the camp, they will be placed in the care of the camp director until time of departure.
5. The camp is closed to all but registered applicants.

Screening for Lice:

Parents and churches must check ALL of their children for head lice prior to leaving for camp. Children will not be allowed to stay at camp if lice or nits are found at check-in.

Medical Information:

A Registered Nurse will be on duty during the entire camp. Parents will be contacted if additional medical treatment is needed. Please send all prescription medication in original package with a signed note (listing medicines, dosage amounts, and dosage times) to be given to nurse at registration.

Do Not send sick children to camp. They will be sent home at the parent's expense.

Heath Valley Campground Camper Rules

1. No tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, firearms, or drugs will be allowed on the campgrounds. Any violation of this rule will result in dismissal from the campgrounds.
2. Profanity is prohibited from use on the campgrounds.
3. Fishing will be allowed with adult supervision. Boating is only allowed with adult supervision and lifeguard present.
4. Male campers are not allowed in any female camper's cabin. Female campers are not allowed in any male camper's cabin.
5. Curfew on the campground will be midnight unless noted otherwise by the director.
6. All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas. Campers must turn over their keys to the camp director or the camp director's designee upon arrival. Those who use the campground facilities should stay on all paths or roads.
7. Dress code for the campgrounds follows the principle of Christian modesty. Swim wear for the girls should include a one piece bathing suit of modest nature. If a two piece is worn, a light colored T-shirt (excluding white) will need to be worn over it. Swim wear for the boys include swim trunks of modest nature. Dress code issues will be handled by the Camp Director if necessary.
8. Cleaning cabins will be done on a daily basis. Any person who intentionally causes damage to buildings and equipment will be held responsible.
9. Water balloons will not be allowed in the cabins, bathhouse or other facilities.
10. The South Arkansas District Church of the Nazarene and the North Arkansas District Church of the Nazarene will not be held liable or responsible for accident or injuries to persons renting the facilities.
11. All campers will sign and abide by the Anti-Bullying policies. This policy is included in packet for parent and camper signatures but will be reviewed at camp campers and camp staff. Infractions can result in dismissal from campground (at the camper's/parents expense).

Each camper will follow all rules established by the camp board, camp directors and those in charge. Rules not followed may result in dismissal from the campgrounds.

Anti-Bullying Policy

Bullying of any type has no place in the camp setting. Heath Valley Campground will endeavor to maintain and provide a camping environment for all persons free of any form of bullying.

Definition

Bullying means the intentional harassment, intimidation, humiliation, ridicule, defamation, or threat or incitement of violence by a camper against a camper or adults. This harassment may occur by a written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that causes or creates a clear and present danger of one or more of the following:

- Physical harm to an adult or student/camper or damage to their property
- A hostile atmosphere due to the severity, persistence or pervasiveness of the act upon another individual
- Substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the Camp

Procedures

Any camper or adult who is a victim of bullying or who witnesses or has reliable information that a camper has been a victim of bullying should report the incident to the Camp Director immediately. The reporting camper/adult identity will be kept anonymous if he/she wants.

The Camp Director will act immediately to investigate complaints and if it is determined that bullying has occurred, the Camp Director will apply discretion as to disciplinary action which may include:

- Immediate discussion with the Camp Director (and possibly Cabin counselor or representative from church)
- Possible removal from activities or suspension of activities for a determined amount of time
- Depending upon severity and situation, possible send-home at the parent's/guardian's expense and mode of transportation. (parents will be notified)

Lice Inspection Form
